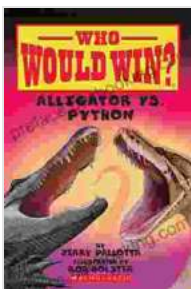
Physical Characteristics

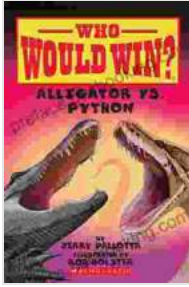

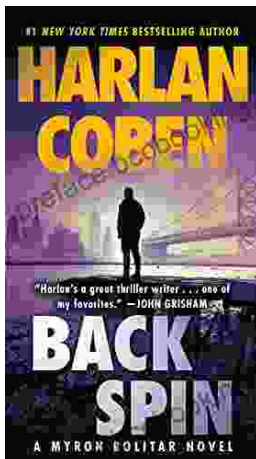
