The cardigan is made with a soft and cuddly yarn, making it perfect for keeping your baby warm and comfortable. The cardigan is also machine washable and dryable, making it easy to care for.

Materials

- Yarn: 100g of DK weight yarn in the main colour
- Needles: 3.75mm (US 5) circular needles

- Buttons: 4 buttons
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

20 stitches and 28 rows to 10cm (4 inches) in garter stitch using 3.75mm (US 5) needles.

Sizes

The cardigan is available in two sizes: 3 months and 6 months.

Instructions

The cardigan is made in one piece, from the bottom up. The pattern includes detailed instructions for each step.

Back

1. Cast on 60 (66) stitches.
2. Work in garter stitch (knit every row) for 30 (34) rows.
3. Shape the armholes: Bind off 3 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
4. Work straight for 16 (18) rows.
5. Shape the shoulders: Bind off 6 stitches at the beginning of the next 4 rows.
6. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Front

1. Cast on 30 (33) stitches.

2. Work in garter stitch for 30 (34) rows.
3. Shape the armhole: Bind off 3 stitches at the beginning of the next row.
4. Work straight for 16 (18) rows.
5. Shape the neck: Bind off 6 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
6. Work straight for 12 (14) rows.
7. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Sleeves

1. Cast on 30 (33) stitches.
2. Work in garter stitch for 30 (34) rows.
3. Shape the top of the sleeve: Bind off 3 stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
4. Work straight for 24 (26) rows.
5. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Assembly

1. Sew the shoulder seams.
2. Sew the sleeve seams.
3. Sew the sleeves to the body.
4. Sew on the buttons.

Finishing

The cardigan is now complete. You can add any embellishments you like, such as embroidery or appliques.

Tips

- Be sure to check your gauge before you begin knitting. This will ensure that your cardigan fits properly.
- If you are a beginner knitter, I recommend using a light-coloured yarn so that you can see your stitches more easily.
- Take your time and enjoy the process of knitting your cardigan. It will be a beautiful and cherished keepsake for years to come.

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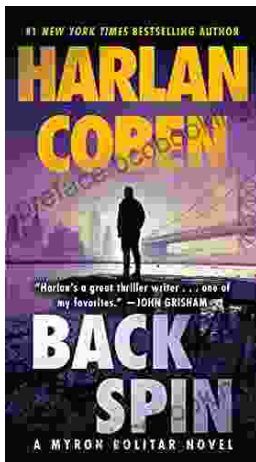
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
