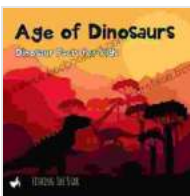

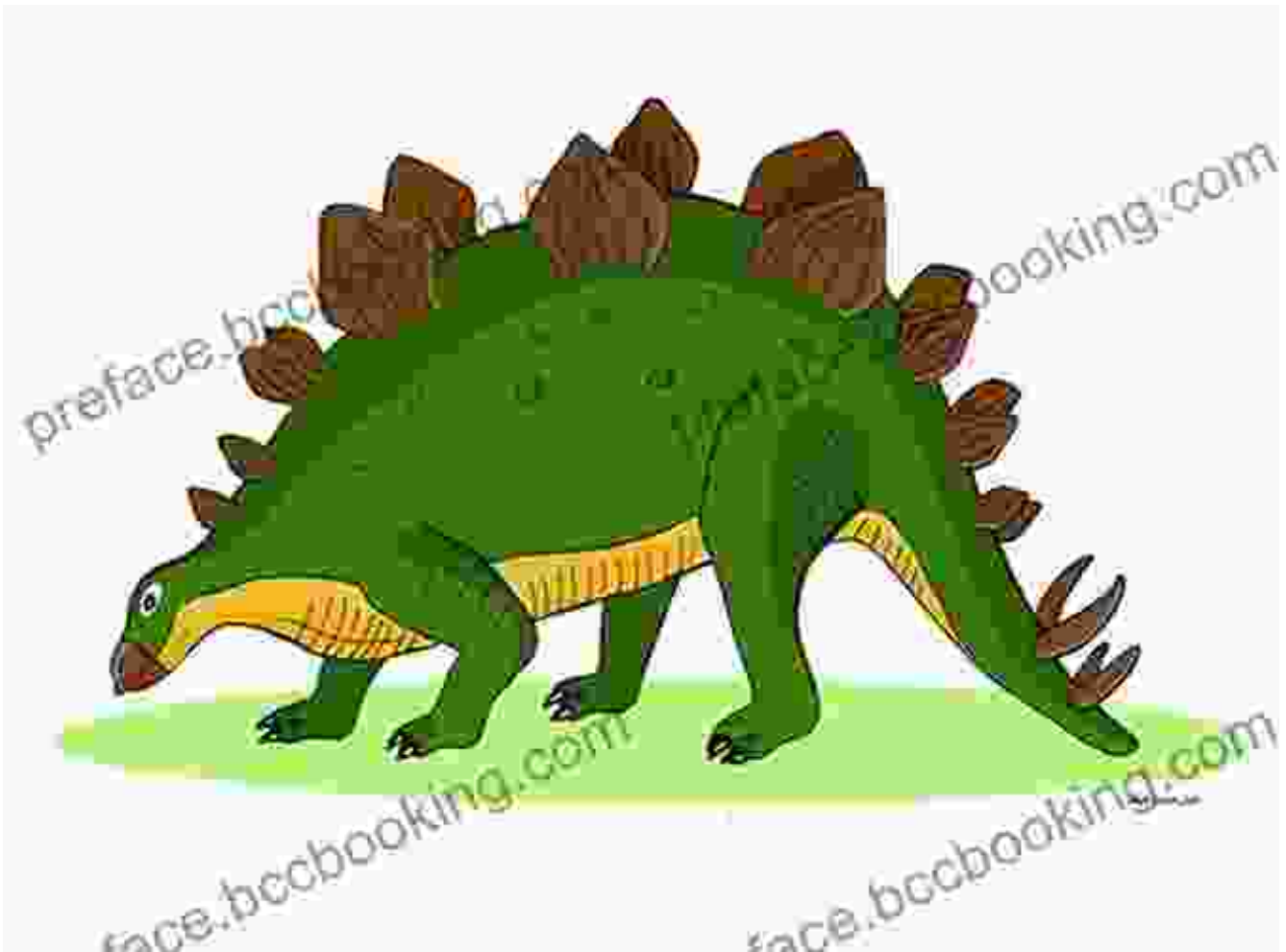
Meet the Mighty Tyrant: Tyrannosaurus Rex

PTERANODON

Pteranodon was a flying reptile that lived 75 million to 85 million years ago during the Upper Cretaceous period.

Pteranodon means "winged and toothless."

Wingspan: 18 feet (5.6 meters)
Height: 6 ft (1.8 m) at the hips
Weight: 55 pounds (25 kg)
Diet: Pteranodons were carnivores and fed on fish, mollusks, crabs, insects, and carcasses of dinosaurs and other animals.

The wing shape suggests that it would have flown like a modern-day albatross.

Pteranodons had toothless beaks, similar to those of modern birds.

The bony crest was probably used to help counterbalance the weight of its massive beak.

SIGNIFICANT FINDS

The first Pteranodon skull was discovered in 1876 by Othniel C. Marsh, in Kansas.

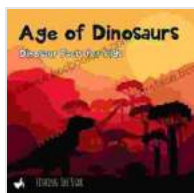

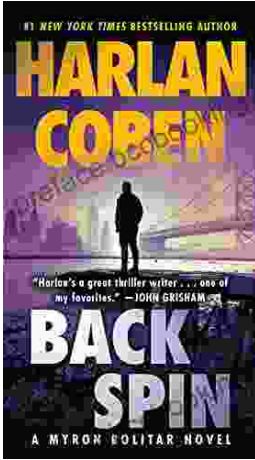
