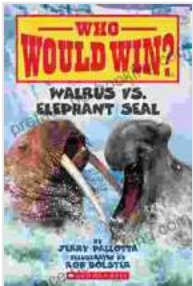


Who Would Win: Walrus Vs Elephant Seal

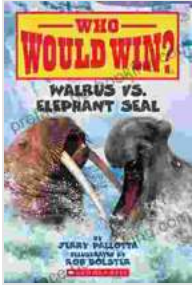

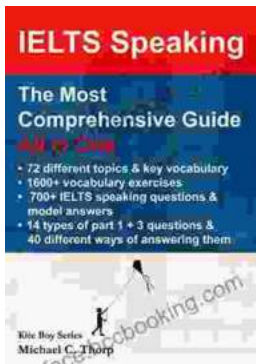

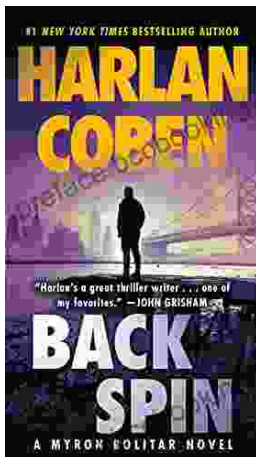
